# IMPORTANT INFORMATION PERTAINING TO ICSE (CLASS X) AND ISC (CLASS XII) YEAR 2023 EXAMINATION RESULTS

### 1. Recheck of ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) Year 2023 Results:

The individual candidates can apply for Recheck of their results using the "Apply for Recheck" button in the CISCE's website: <a href="https://cisce.org">https://cisce.org</a>

The Head of Schools can apply for the Recheck of the results of their school candidates through the CAREERS Portal.

The charges for the recheck of ICSE (Class X) Year 2023 results will be Rs. 1000/- per paper, per candidate.

The charges for the recheck of ISC (Class XII) Year 2023 results will be Rs. 1000/- per subject, per candidate.

The Recheck module will be activated on 14th May, 2023, at 3.00 pm and will be available till 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2023. No further request for recheck of results of the ICSE/ISC Examination Year 2023 will be entertained thereafter.

#### 2. Compartment Examination and Improvement Examination.

In keeping with the recommendations of NEP 2020, CISCE is introducing Improvement Examination from Examination Year 2023 onwards.

The Compartment Examination and Improvement Examination will be conducted in July 2023. The details pertaining to these examinations will be uploaded on the CISCE's website, shortly.

#### 3. DigiLocker:

CISCE shall make all digitally signed copies of the Statement of Marks and Pass Certificates available for the candidates who have taken the ICSE/ISC Year 2023 Examination through the DigiLocker facility established by the Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), Government of India. The digitally signed documents shall be available through DigiLocker after one month of the Publication of Results.

For signing up for DigiLocker (digilocker.gov.in) a mobile number will be required. The mobile number will be authenticated by sending OTP (one-time password) followed by selecting a username and password. This will create the DigiLocker account. After the DigiLocker account is successfully created, one can download the digitally signed documents issued by CISCE.
